Once again it is time to send out a newsletter for 2011. Nancy (Treasurer) has a new address **30146 CR 1170 Minco, OK 73059**

We wanted to let you know we have enough money from last years contributions and interest on the CD to pay for the mowing this year.

The CD money is used as a perpetual fund and only the interest from the CD can be used for mowing. We have a \$25,500 CD, the 2010 interest only amounted to \$596.00, so if this is all we make in 2011 we will have to collect at least \$800.00 this Memorial Day weekend. to pay for the mowing in 2012.

I am sure we will be able to raise this amount since we have some very dedicated family members that contribute every year. We gave Junior a extra 150.00 this year for gas.

We are asking for volunteers to sit a few hours at the cemetery Memorial Day weekend to take contributions and just be there to help those who come out and do not know the location of certain graves. We will have the books available to look up obituaries, grave locations, etc.

In 2010 there were three burials made at the cemetery; Herman Ott, Deanna (Rowell) Smith & Raymond McMahon. There is a website called Findagrave.com, I have added the tombstone names and plan to get pictures and obituaries put on by next year. Let me know if you have any obituaries of your loved ones that you want added to the website. We have some very interesting and historical history of our old settlers buried at Hazel Dell, for example here is the obituary of Lewis Baker, one of our early settlers

HINTON RECORD & LOOKEBA LIGHT 23 Jun 1905

Lewis Baker living 3 miles east of Scott died Saturday Jun 17 at 1 O'clock, the funeral services conducted by Rev Hoover was held at the house at 10 a.m. and the remains were laid to rest at Hazel Dell cemetery. The deceased leaves a wife and 5 children to mourn his death. He was a very highly respected citizen and his loss will be felt by the entire community. He was a uncle of Mrs. Oscar Davis of this place

MINCO MINSTREL 30 June 1905

"Basque-Tedda News"

Louis Baker died at his home west of Basque June 17 and was buried at Hazel Dell on June 18. He suffered from consumption for several weeks.
